Swimming Pool Rules & Regulations

(Revised: May 1st, 2006)

Registration & Fees:

1. All members and their guests must register immediately upon entrance. Sign-in at the concession stand. Guest fees must be paid before admittance. An active member must accompany all guests. Guest fees are \$5.00 per guest per day with a 5 guest limit per day per membership. For special arrangements call Leslie @ 575-9229.
2. **Active bondholder's** attending a party at the Tanglewood Swimming Pool will NOT be charged a guest fee.
3. No more than 5 guests per membership are allowed per day. More than 5 guests, constitutes a "party" and parties are after hours only from 8pm-11pm. Private parties can be booked with Leslie, call 575-9229 for further information.

General Rules:

1. All persons using any pool facility do so at their own risk. The Tanglewood House of Victoria, Inc. will not be held responsible for any accidents, falls, drowning's, death, injuries, loss and/or damage to personal property; this includes vehicles parked on TWH property.
2. Lifeguards have FULL authority to regulate conduct at the pool, enforce compliance with all swimming pool rules and restrict swimmers to certain areas if deemed necessary for their own safety. The penalty for violation of the rules may result in a "time-out". If the behavior persists and at least 3 time-outs have been issued, suspension for the remainder of the day will occur. Serious offenses will cause termination of Membership – for the remainder of the summer. Unfavorable behavior or language by guests will be handled at the on-duty lifeguard's discretion. **Members ARE responsible for their guests. Guests are not permitted to stay on the property when their (host) member leaves.** The cost of any property damage will be charged to the member responsible.
3. All swimmers must be attired in proper, respectful, family friendly swimming apparel at all times. (No cut-offs & no thongs). Babies and/or toddlers must wear "swimming diapers".

Health & Safety Rules:

1. No one may swim unless a lifeguard is in a lifeguard stand - on duty. **No adults in the pool during lifeguard breaks** (State Law, effective - October, 2005).
2. Any person having a skin disease, open or bleeding sores, lice, sore/inflamed eyes, nasal/ear discharge or any communicable disease will not be allowed to use the pool.
3. Running, playing tag, playing football, wrestling, pushing, horseplay, towel popping, throwing persons into the pool and all other dangerous conduct is prohibited. Foul or racist language will not be permitted.
4. No eating, drinking, chewing gum or use of tobacco while you are in the water. **Alcohol and/or tobacco use by minors is illegal.** If an on-duty lifeguard or Board Member witness use, the City of Victoria Police Department will be contacted immediately; parents will be contacted by the Police Department not by Tanglewood. Alcohol in moderation by ADULTS is permitted; but keep it respectful and responsible. No glass bottles or containers are permitted.
5. All floating or diving devices must be approved by an on-duty lifeguard. Only soft/squishy balls intended for swimming pool use are allowed. Footballs, baseballs, golf balls, soccer balls, glow sticks and water balloons are **NOT** permitted.
6. **Slide is for children NOT adults.** Weight limit for slide is 200 pounds.
7. The water area in front of the diving board and slide must be kept clear. No diving permitted from the sides of the diving board. Only one person at a time on the diving board and/or slide. No toys/floats allowed in the diving board area.
8. **No children under the age of 10 will be permitted** on the Tanglewood property unattended. **A responsible person must accompany all children under 10 years of age.** A responsible person means: an older sibling (15 years old – minimum), parent, guardian or babysitter.
9. The baby pool is limited to children 5 years or younger. **An adult or babysitter must supervise children in the baby pool. No lifeguard on duty for the baby pool.** Only certified pool toys and floats are permitted in the baby pool.
10. The pool will be cleared during inclement weather and at the sole discretion of the on-duty lifeguards. No swimming for 20 minutes after each issue of thunder. This is a State law. A Board Member may close the pool at his/her discretion during inclement weather.
